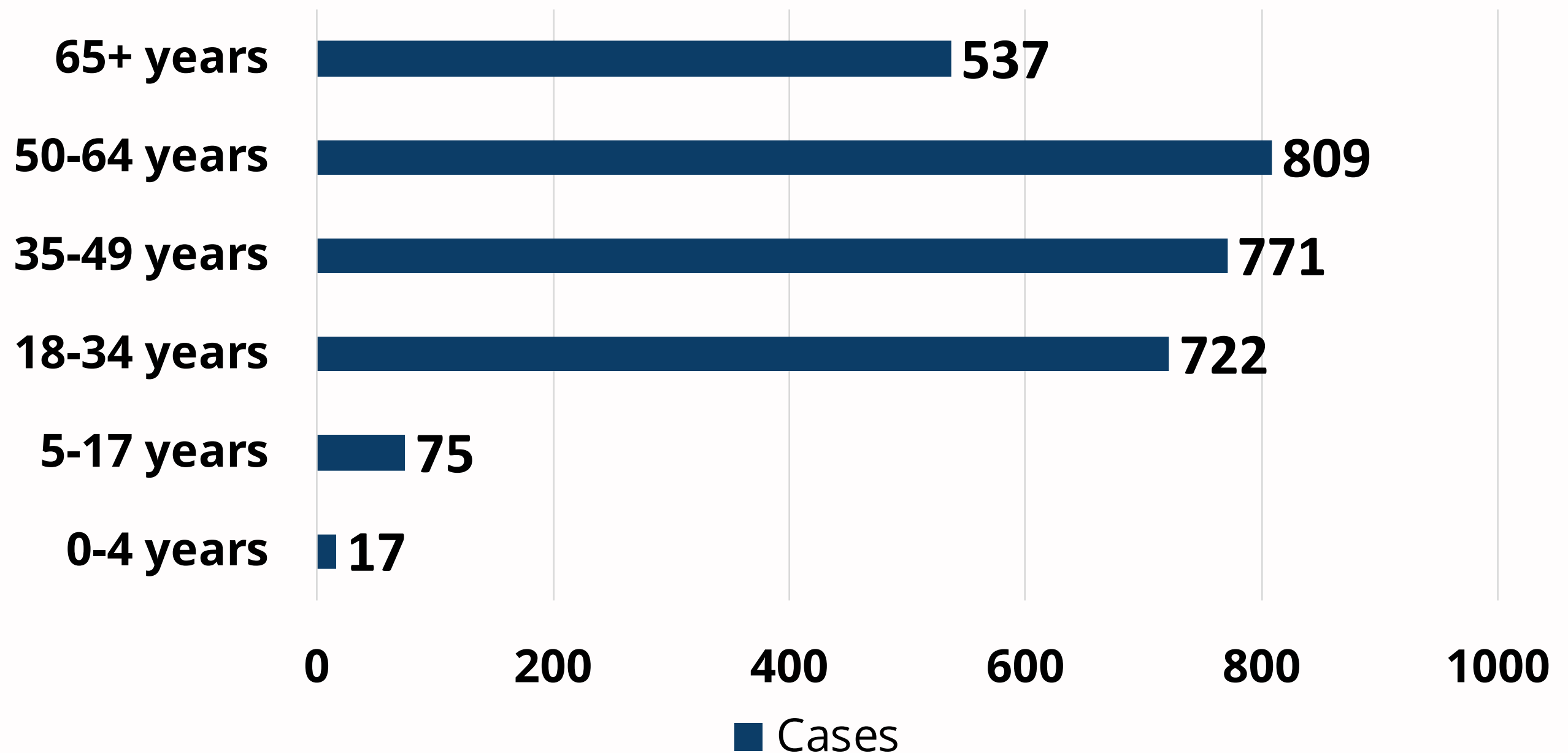

- ✓ **MARCH 11**  
First confirmed positive case of COVID-19
- ✓ **MARCH 12**  
State of Emergency Declaration
- ✓ **MARCH 16**  
Closed restaurants and bars
- ✓ **March 21**  
Closed Delaware beaches
- ✓ **MARCH 22**  
Stay-At-Home Order
- ✓ **MARCH 23**  
Schools closed until May 15

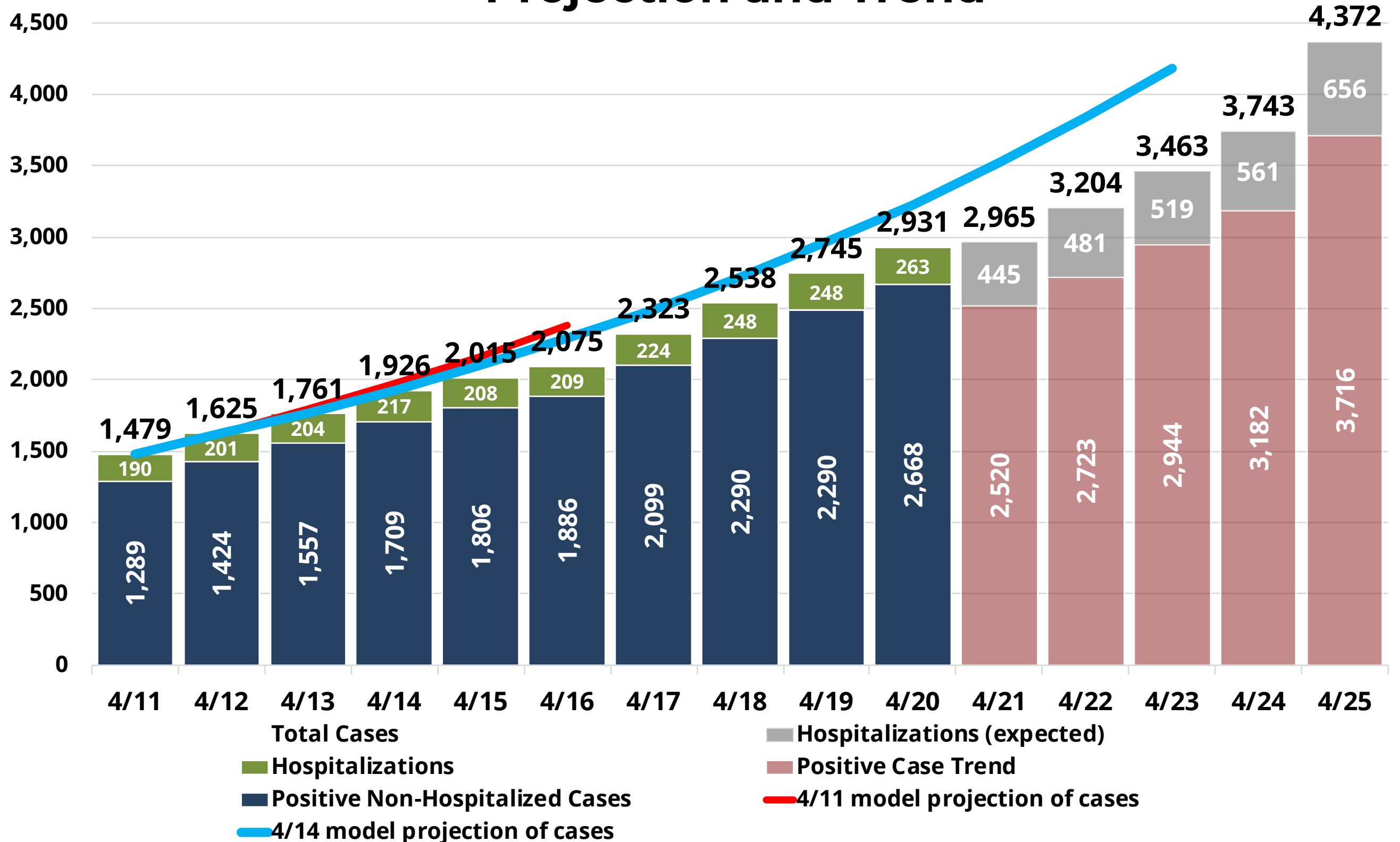
- ✓ **MARCH 29**  
Out-of-state travelers to self-quarantine for 14 days
- ✓ **APRIL 1**  
Additional business restrictions
- ✓ **APRIL 2**  
Community Call-to-Action for supplies and materials
- ✓ **APRIL 6**  
Banned short-term and commercial rentals
- ✓ **APRIL 15**  
Stricter measures in long-term care facilities

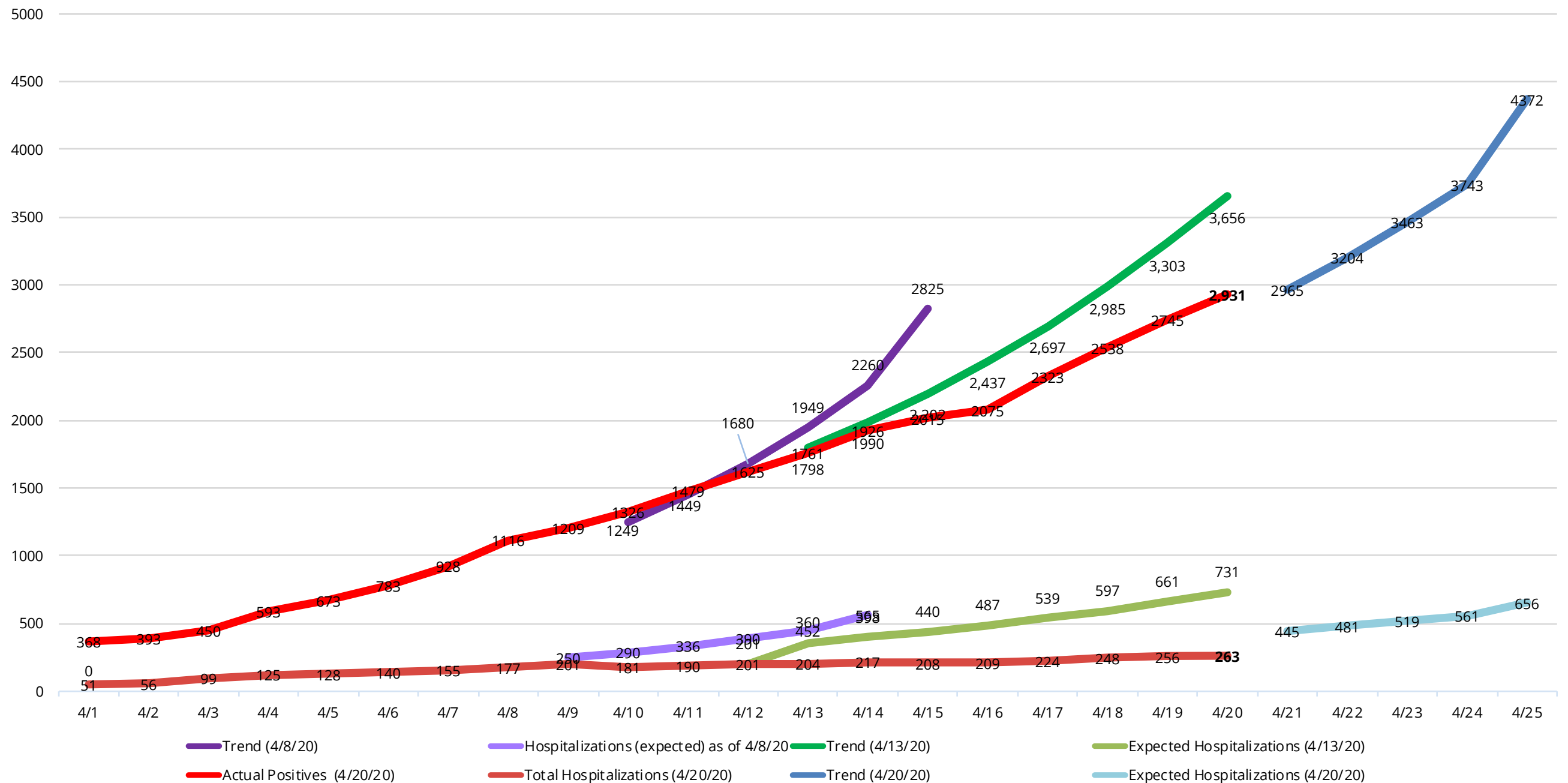

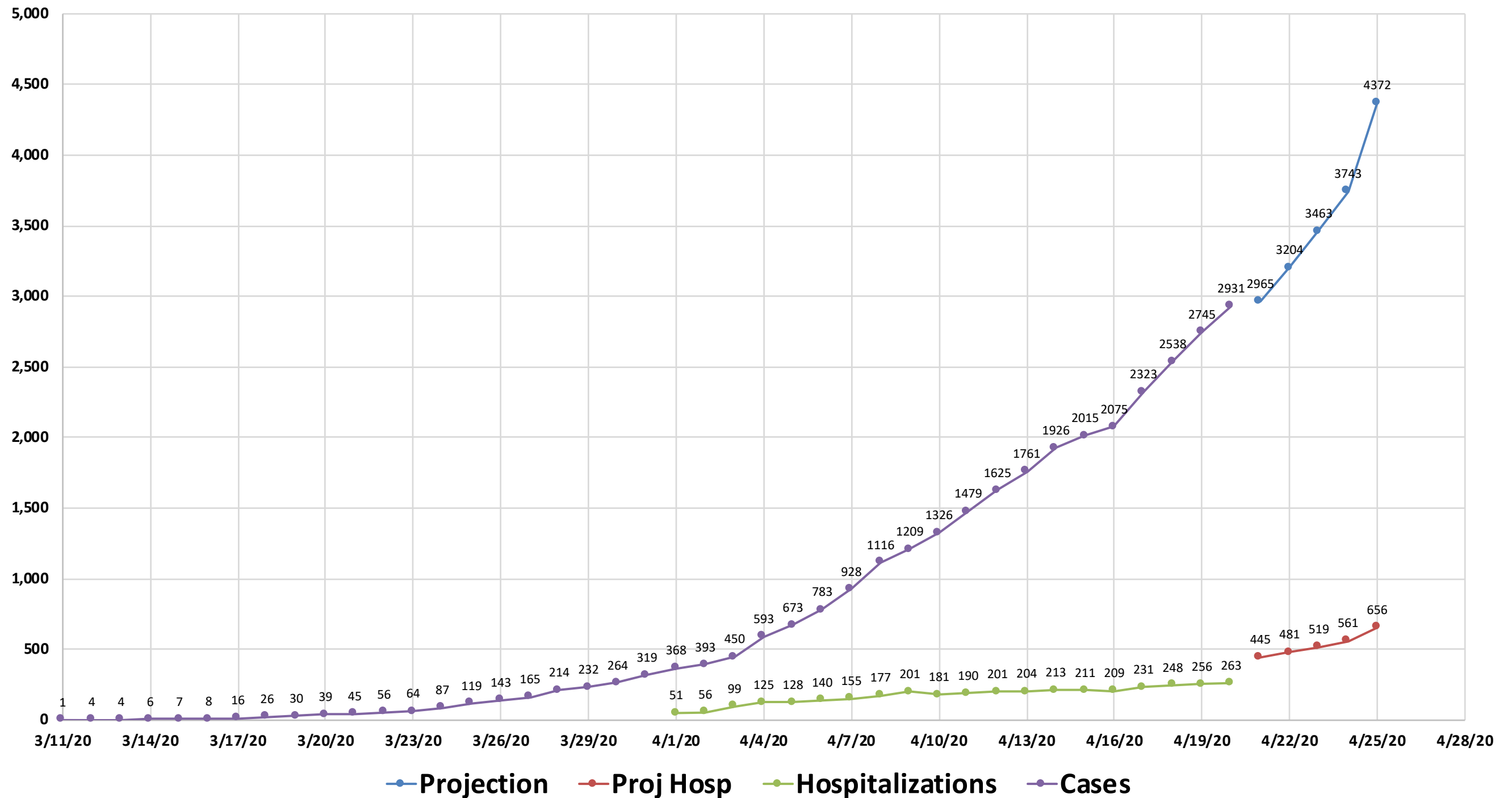

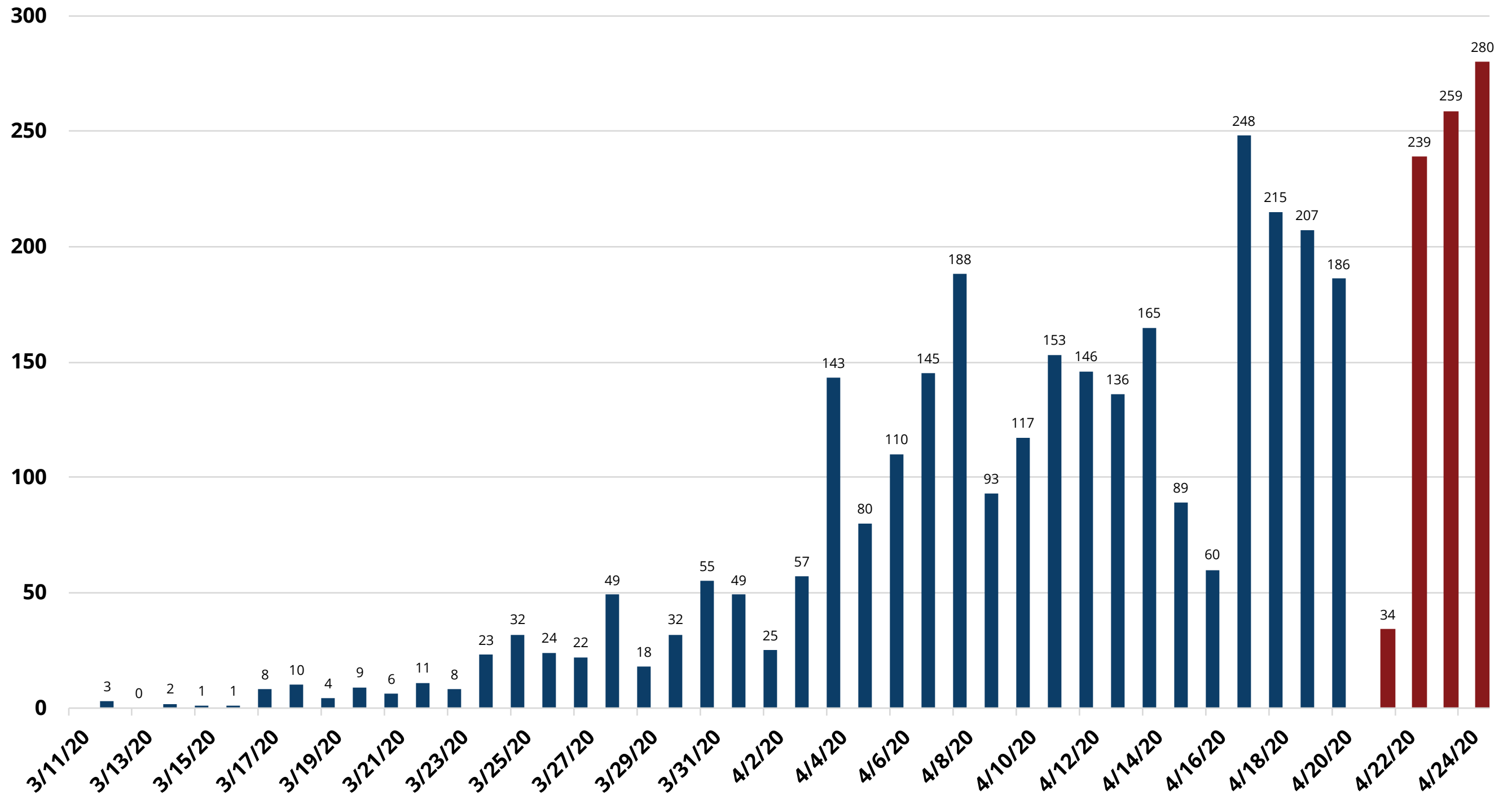

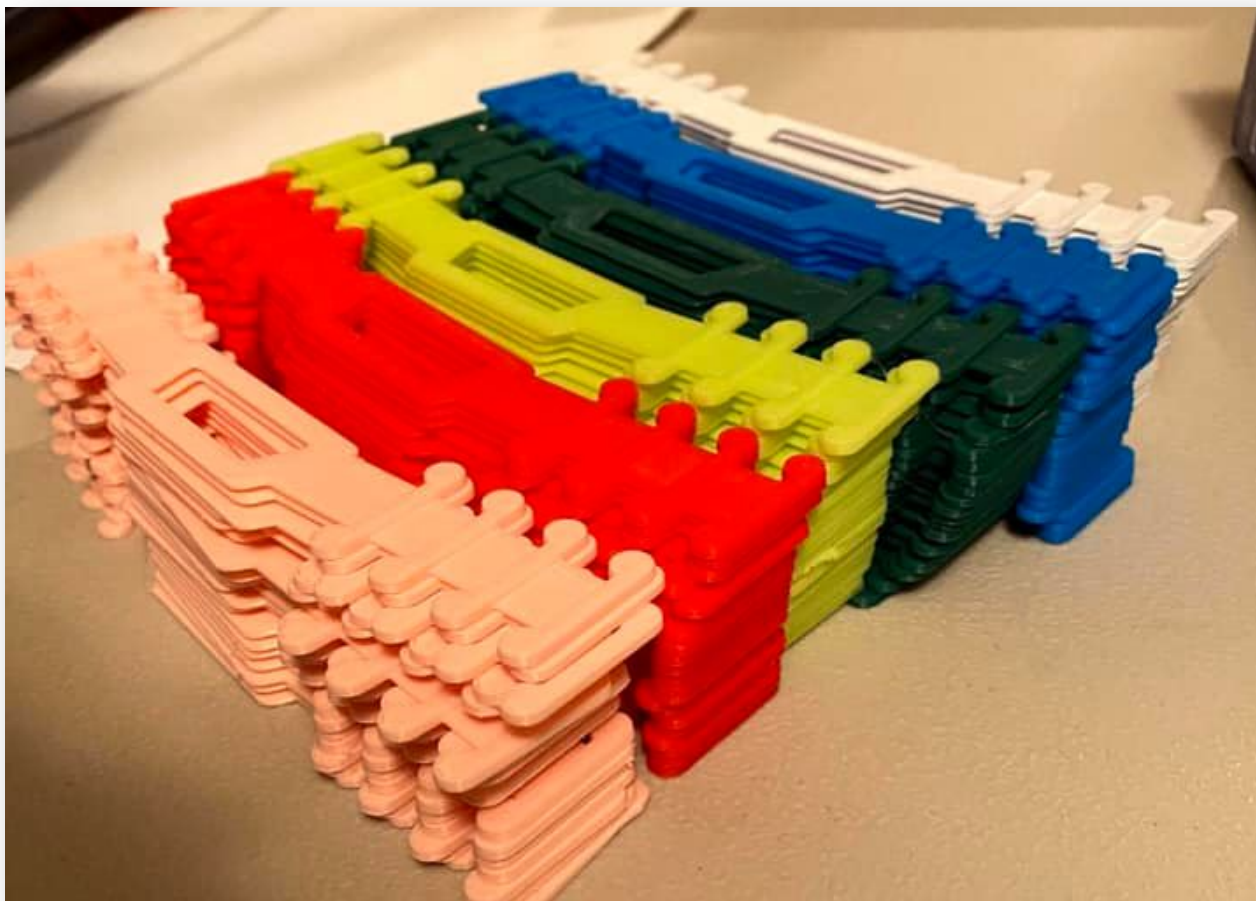

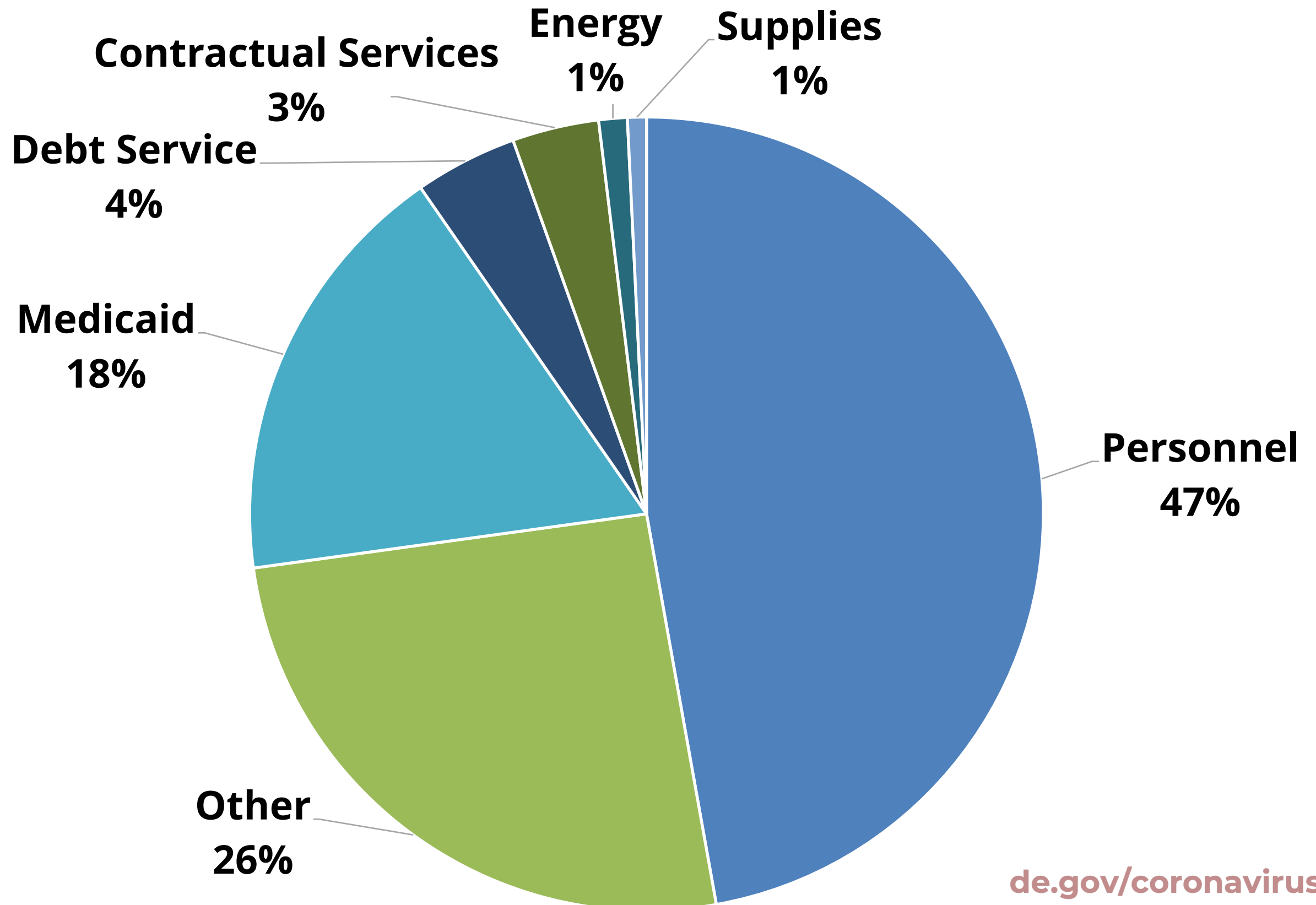


# State Budget Impact
