## **TERMINATION OF DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE STATE OF DELAWARE DUE TO TROPICAL STORM ISAIAS**

**WHEREAS**, on Tuesday, August 4, 2020, the State of Delaware experienced a tropical storm with high winds, heavy rainfall, and tornadoes occurring throughout the state, resulting in coastal flooding, downed trees and power lines leading to potentially extended power outages, and other road hazards that made driving dangerous and created potentially life-threatening conditions for the citizens of Delaware; and


**WHEREAS**, considering the foregoing conditions, I declared a State of Emergency on Tuesday, August 4, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. E.D.T.; and

**WHEREAS**, the foregoing emergency has been dealt with to the extent that conditions necessitating a State of Emergency no longer exist.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN C. CARNEY**, do hereby declare that:
